Sub: Rates of Demmurage in the case of Coal and/or Coke consignment

Please refer to ECoR's letter No.CCM/95/DC/Pt.V/33 dt.09.01.2019 seeking Board's guidance regarding methodology for calculation of rates of Demurrage Charge mentioned vide corrigendum 6 under reference (ii) and granting waiver of Demurrage Charge in the case of coal and/or coke consignment.

As regards methodology for calculation of Demurrage Charge in the case of coal and/or coke consignment, slab-wise rates of Demurrage Charge shall be applied.

Illustration:

If duration of excess detention of a coal and/or coke rake is 09 hours(beyond permissible free time), the rates of Demurrage Charge shall be computed as under:

- i) For first 4 hours@2 times of the base rate (in the slab upto 4 hours)
- ii) For next 4 hours @2.5 times of the base rate (in the slab beyond 4 hours upto 8 hours)
- iii) For remaining 1 hour@3 times of the base rate (in the slab beyond 8 hours)

As regards waiver of Demurrage Charge in the case of coal and/or coke consignment, extant guidelines in this regard is stipulated in Chapter-III of Rates Master Circular-Demmurage-Wharfage-Waiver2016/0 under reference(i), which is self-contained, and continues to be in force.
